APPROVAL OF ISSUANCE
OF GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE

APPLICANT: GTE California Incorporated
Attn: Robert Goodman
P.O. Box 176
Courtland, California 95615

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 1.49-acre parcel of tide and submerged land,
Sacramento River, vicinity of Clarksburg.

LAND USE: Existing submarine cable, proposed for
abandonment, and the proposed installation of
two buried four-inch conduits adjacent to the
existing cable.

TERMS OF EXISTING PERMIT:
An indefinite period beginning April 22, 1955.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt; Section 7901, Public Utilities Code.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Filing fee and processing costs have been
received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 2, Replacement or Reconstruction, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15302(c).

Authority: P.R.C. 21084 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15300.

2. GTE California Incorporated has applied to the State Lands Commission for permission to abandon an existing submarine cable in place, and to install two buried, four-inch conduits adjacent to the existing facility, in replacement of its function. Both the abandonment and new construction is within a right-of-way covered in permit PRC 1502.
3. The records of the Commission disclose that the existing submarine cable permit at the subject location was originally granted to the Delta Telephone and Telegraph Company, permit No. PRC 1502, executed by the State on April 22, 1955, to run for an indefinite term, effective upon the date of document execution. That permit has never been terminated nor assigned to another party.
4. Effective upon the close of business, December 31, 1964, Delta Telephone and Telegraph Company was merged into General Telephone Company of California, the former name of GTE California Incorporated, which assumed all the obligations of Delta pursuant to Section 4124 of the Corporation Code of California, including the duties and obligations in permit PRC 1502. Such rights and duties in the permit inured to the Applicant by operation of law, and no action is required of the Commission in that regard.

5. The right-of-way for the facilities to be covered in the proposed agreement is a 20-foot wide strip in the Sacramento River.
6. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$270.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS A CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 2, REPLACEMENT OR RECONSTRUCTION, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15302(c).
2. AUTHORIZE, EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 7, 1988, THE ISSUANCE OF PERMIT PRC 1502, BETWEEN THE COMMISSION AND GTE CALIFORNIA INCORPORATED, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ABANDONMENT IN PLACE OF AN EXISTING SUBMARINE CABLE, AND THE PLACEMENT OF TWO, BURIED FOUR-INCH CONDUITS ADJACENT THERETO, ALL WITHIN THE STRIP OF LAND COVERED BY SAID PERMIT PRC 1502, SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO, AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.




LAND DESCRIPTION




