APPROVE ACCEPTANCE OF A QUITCLAIM DEED

PERMITTEE: United States Borax & Chemical Corporation
3075 Wilshire Boulevard
Los Angeles, California 90010-1294

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Vacant State-owned school lands further
described as - Section 16, Township 2 North,
Range 23 East, SBM, southeast San Bernardino
County, approximately 50 miles north of Blythe,
California.

LAND USE: Conduct mineral prospecting activities for
precious metals and valuable minerals other
than oil and gas, geothermal resources or sand
and gravel on 639.52 acres.

TERM OF PERMIT: This two-year mineral prospecting permit was
approved by the Commission on January 17, 1990
and was effective on February 1, 1990. The
executed quitclaim deed was received by
Commission staff on May 3, 1990.

REASON FOR QUITCLAIM: The Permittee requested approval from the
Commission on February 20, 1990 to assign this
permit to Kennecott Exploration Company of Salt
Lake City, Utah. Since that date, Kennecott
Exploration has determined that it is no longer
interested in the permit area.

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PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES, AND EXPENSES:

- A. The mineral prospecting permit quitclaim deed has been duly executed by the Permittee.
- B. Permittee has complied with Paragraph 18 on Page 7 of this permit document which requires restoration of the lands to those conditions existing on the effective date of the permit.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. There was no prospecting activity conducted on the permitted lands.
2. The permitted lands are not within current S-11 boundaries and not within a BLM Wilderness Study Area.
3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State's CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Code Regs. 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of CEQA because it is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State's CEQA Guidelines.


