REQUEST FOR RATIFICATION OF AMENDMENT TO  
SACHSE ENGINEERING ASSOCIATES  
TO CONDUCT A NEAR SHORE SURVEY TO IDENTIFY  
SUBMERGED STRUCTURES THAT CONSTITUTE  
A HAZARD TO THE PUBLIC

The hazards identified during the beach hazard removal process that exist offshore between 100 and 500 feet beyond median high tide, within three (3) feet of the surface, were not within the Hazard Removal Programs Inventory since they had never been observed before.

To determine if additional hazards exist within the surf zone, SLC amended the contract with Sachse Engineering Associates (SEA). SEA is currently under contract for the Local Marine Fisheries Impact Program where they are identifying seafloor hazards that present a hazard to the fishing industry. The contractor will utilize side-scan sonar, magnetometer, and video camera to survey the areas where SLC has removed beach hazards. The contractor will provide maps, video, and a written report providing the location and quantity of hazards that yet exist within the surf zone at Ellwood, Montecito, Summerland, Goleta, El Capitain, and Isla Vista recreational areas.

Based upon the original bid presented by SEA, the cost associated with this survey is being provided at a savings of 20 percent. SLC has obtained Sole Source Exemption approval from Office of Small and Minority Business for this amendment. The estimated cost of the survey is \$36,500 and will be funded through the hazards removal program.
