DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: Cerritos Bahia Marina
Attn: Stuart A. Monfort
5199 E. Pacific Coast Hwy, Suite 610
Long Beach, California 90804

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
Granted, mineral reservation lands in Alamitos
Bay, Los Angeles County.

LAND USE: Dredge a maximum 8,000 cubic yards of material
to maintain navigability at Cerritos Bahia
Marina. The material will be disposed of at an
approved upland site at the Port of Long Beach.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial Period: One year beginning September 1,
1990.

Royalty: \$0.25 per cubic yard.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Filing and processing fees have been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. A Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) was prepared and adopted for this project by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The document was circulated for public review as required by State and local laws, and notice was given meeting the standards in 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15072(a). Therefore, pursuant to 14 Cal. Code Regs. 15225, staff recommends the use of the federal FONSI in place of a Negative Declaration.





IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT THE FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (FONSI) PREPARED AND ADOPTED FOR THIS PROJECT BY THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA AND THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO CAL. CODE REGS. 15225, ADOPT SUCH FEDERAL DOCUMENT FOR USE IN PLACE OF A NEGATIVE DECLARATION.
2. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT AS APPROVED, WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
3. AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ISSUE TO THE CERRITOS BAHIA MARINA THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION. SAID PERMIT SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM VOLUME OF 8,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FOR ONE YEAR BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 1990 FROM ALAMITOS BAY, LOS ANGELES COUNTY. THE MATERIAL WILL BE DEPOSITED AT AN APPROVED UPLAND SITE AT THE PORT OF LONG BEACH. A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR ANY MATERIAL DREDGED. SUCH PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON THE APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.
