DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: San Mateo County Harbor District  
#1 Johnson Pier  
Half Moon Bay, CA 94019

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Granted mineral reservation lands in Pillar Point Harbor, San Mateo County.

LAND USE: Dredge a maximum 150 cubic yards of material as part of the Pillar Point Harbor Boat Ramp Facility project. The dredged material will be utilized for upland portions of the project.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial Period: Two years beginning  
October 29, 1990.

Royalty: No charge because the project  
is by a public agency for  
public benefit.

\$0.25 per cubic yard for any  
material used for private  
benefit or commercial sale  
purposes.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee has been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The California Coastal Commission (CCC), a functional equivalent agency under Section 21080.5 of the CEQA Act:
  - a. served as the lead agency under CEQA;
  - b. considered the project described herein; and
  - c. found that the project, as proposed, will not have a significant effect on the environment.

Under Section 15252 of the CEQA Guidelines, the State Lands Commission may use the environmental analysis made by the California Coastal Commission in its consideration of this project.

Authority: Sections 21083 and 21087 of the CEQA.

APPROVALS REQUIRED:

United States Army Corps of Engineers, Regional Water Quality Control Board, the California Coastal Commission, and County of San Mateo.



IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION, A FUNCTIONAL EQUIVALENT AGENCY UNDER SECTION 21080.5 OF THE CEQA, HAS CONSIDERED THE PROPOSED PROJECT AND DETERMINED THAT THE PROJECT, AS PROPOSED, WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
2. FIND THAT THE COMMISSION HAS CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION AND CONCURS WITH THE CONCLUSIONS AND FINDINGS CONTAINED THEREIN, 14 CAL. CODE REGS., SECTION 15252.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 1 9 (CONT'D)

3. AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ISSUE TO THE SAN MATEO COUNTY HARBOR DISTRICT THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION. THE PERMIT SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM 150 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM PILLAR POINT HARBOR, SAN MATEO COUNTY FOR TWO YEARS BEGINNING OCTOBER 29, 1990. THE DREDGED MATERIAL WILL BE USED FOR UPLAND PORTIONS OF THE HARBOR DISTRICTS BOAT LAUNCH FACILITY PROJECT. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED BECAUSE THE PROJECT IS BY A PUBLIC AGENCY FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT. A FEE OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES. THE PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON THE APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.
