DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT:

City of Eureka
532 "K" Street
Eureka, California 95501

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Granted, mineral reservation lands in Humboldt Bay, Eureka,
Humboldt County.

LAND USE:

Dredge a maximum 300 cubic yards of material to maintain a
navigable depth for operation of a newly constructed public
boat-launching float at a recently constructed public
recreation center.

The dredged material will be dewatered at a temporary upland
disposal site at dock "B" and later trucked to the upland
Humboldt County Landfill site for permanent disposal.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

One (1) year beginning August 13, 1991.

Royalty:

No charge because the project is by a public agency for
public benefit.

\$0.25 per cubic yard for any material used for private
benefit or commercial sale purposes.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Filing fee has been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The California Coastal Commission (CCC), a "functional equivalent agency" under Section 21080.5 of the CEQA has:
 - (a) served as the lead agency under CEQA;
 - (b) considered the project described herein; and
 - (c) found that the project, as proposed, will not have a significant effect on the environment.

Under Section 15252 of the CEQA Guidelines, the State Lands Commission may use the environmental analysis made by the California Coastal Commission in its consideration of this project.

Authority: Sections 21083 and 21087 of the CEQA.

2. To coincide with the time schedule of other work being done at the site within a funding mandated completion date of September 1991, the dredging work has been started.

APPROVALS OBTAINED:

United States Army Corps of Engineers, Regional Water Quality Control Board, the California Coastal Commission, Humboldt Harbor District, and City of Eureka.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION, A FUNCTIONAL EQUIVALENT AGENCY UNDER SECTION 21080.5 OF THE CEQA, HAS CONSIDERED THE PROPOSED PROJECT AND DETERMINED THAT THE PROJECT, AS PROPOSED, WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.

2. FIND THAT THE COMMISSION HAS CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS PREPARED BY THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL COMMISSION AND CONCURS WITH THE CONCLUSIONS AND FINDINGS CONTAINED THEREIN, 14 CAL. CODE REGS., SECTION 15252.
3. AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF EUREKA THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION. THE PERMIT SHALL ALLOW DREDGING A MAXIMUM 300 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM HUMBOLDT BAY, HUMBOLDT COUNTY, FOR ONE YEAR BEGINNING AUGUST 13, 1991. THE DREDGED MATERIAL WILL BE TEMPORARILY DISPOSED OF AT AN UPLAND SITE AT DOCK "B" AND PERMANENTLY DISPOSED OF AT THE UPLAND HUMBOLDT COUNTY LANDFILL. NO ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED BECAUSE THE PROJECT IS BY A PUBLIC AGENCY FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT. A FEE OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED FOR MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES. THE PERMITTED ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON THE APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT AGENCIES.




EXHIBIT "A"
