**DREDGING LEASE**

**LESSEE:**

Napa County Flood Control  
and Water Conservation District  
1195 Third Street  
Napa, California 94559

**AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:**

Sovereign lands located in Napa River, Napa County.

**AUTHORIZED USE:**

Dredge a maximum of 334,000 cubic yards of sediment from the Napa River to maintain a safe navigable depth in the federal navigational channel.

**LEASE TERM:**

Five years, beginning September 1, 1997.

**CONSIDERATION:**

No royalty will be charged for aquatic disposal; \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged for any material used for private benefit or commercial sale purposes.

**OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

1. A Environmental Assessment Review/Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for this project by the United States Army Corps of Engineers/Napa County Flood Control District. The California State Lands Commission's staff has reviewed such document.
2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.



DREDGING A MAXIMUM OF 334,000 CUBIC YARDS OF SEDIMENT  
FROM THE NAPA RIVER TO MAINTAIN A SAFE NAVIGABLE DEPTH  
IN THE FEDERAL NAVIGATIONAL CHANNEL. SUCH PERMITTED  
ACTIVITY IS CONTINGENT UPON APPLICANT'S COMPLIANCE WITH  
APPLICABLE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS  
ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS. NO  
ROYALTY SHALL BE CHARGED AS THE PROJECT WILL RESULT IN  
A PUBLIC BENEFIT; \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD SHALL BE CHARGED  
FOR ANY MATERIAL USED FOR PRIVATE BENEFIT OR  
COMMERCIAL SALE PURPOSES.
