RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANT:

Theodore Bruns Revocable Living Trust Dated June 30, 1992
3017 Garden Highway
Sacramento, California 95833

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the Garden Highway, near
the city of Sacramento (APN 225-0200-002), Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 8 foot by 12 foot floating dock.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning March 28, 1999.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905 (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

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2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THEODORE BRUNS REVOCABLE LIVING TRUST DATED JUNE 30, 1992, OF A TEN-YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE, BEGINNING MARCH 28, 1999, FOR CONTINUED USE AND MAINTENANCE OF AN EXISTING FLOATING DOCK ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; NO MONETARY CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 6503.5; LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF NO LESS THAN \$300,000.


