**CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE AWARD OF THE ROYALTY OIL SALES  
CONTRACT, OIL AND GAS LEASE NOS. PRC 91, PRC 163,  
PRC 425, PRC 426 AND E-392,  
HUNTINGTON BEACH OIL FIELD,  
ORANGE COUNTY**

**BACKGROUND:**

At its meeting on December 3, 1999, the California State Lands Commission authorized the sale of royalty crude oil from several Oil and Gas Leases in Orange County. Paramount Petroleum Company (Paramount) is presently purchasing the State's share of crude oil from these leases. Paramount is paying the State a bonus of \$0.251 per barrel above a base price defined as the highest price posted in the Huntington Beach Field among the postings of Chevron, Exxon Mobil, Union and Equiva. The State's share of production is approximately 1,000 barrels per day. The present royalty oil sales contact is for a term of 12 months. Royalty oil from these leases may be taken in kind or returned to the lessee on 90 days previous written notice.

A Notice Inviting Bids for a new Royalty Oil Sales Contract to run from June 1, 2000 until June 1, 2001, was published in the Orange County Register on December 20, 1999, and sent to all known interested parties. Bids were received and opened on January 6, 2000. Exhibit A shows the results of the bidding.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Fiscal and Legal reviews of the submitted bid material were done by the SLC Auditing and Legal Units respectively. Based on the results of these reviews, the

highest responsible bidder has been identified on Exhibit A. Staff recommends awarding of the new Royalty Oil Sales Contract for Oil and Gas Lease Nos. PRC 91, PRC 163, PRC 425, PRC 426 and E-392, to the highest responsible bidder identified on Exhibit A.
