### RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

#### APPLICANTS:

Charles R. Williams and Josephine F. Williams  
19900 Sherman Island Cross Road  
Rio Vista, California 94571

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the San Joaquin River, at Sherman Island, Sacramento County.

#### AUTHORIZED USE:

Replacement and extension of a recreational dock consisting of the following: a 15 foot by 81 foot platform, a 5 foot by 17 foot gangway, a 10 foot by 30 foot dock, and a 32 foot by 46 foot U-shaped dock.

#### LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning November 1, 2001.

#### CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Approval of this item will allow Applicants to replace and extend a recreational dock. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because they are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.
2. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of

the CEQA under the general rule that the CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The staff believes, based on the information available to it, that there is no possibility that this project may have a significant effect on the environment.

Authority: Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061(b) (3).

3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
