RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE

APPLICANTS:

William Ray Planchon and Patricia V. Planchon

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign lands in the Sacramento River, near the city of West Sacramento, Yolo County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Proposed construction, use, and maintenance of a floating boat dock and walkway.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 1, 2003.

CONSIDERATION:

No monetary consideration pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$300,000.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Applicants own the uplands adjoining the lease premises.
2. Applicants qualify for a Recreational Pier Lease because the Applicants are natural persons who have improved the littoral land with, and use the upland for, a single-family dwelling.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C14 (CONT'D)

3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 3, New Construction of Small Structures; Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905(c)(1).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and Title 14, California Code of Regulations, section 15300 and Title 2, California Code of Regulations, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code sections 6370, et seq. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

California Department of Fish and Game; U.S. Department of Interior, U.S. Department of Fish and Wildlife Service; and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.



PLANCHON OF A TEN YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER LEASE, BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2003, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, USE, AND MAINTENANCE OF A FLOATING BOAT DOCK AND WALKWAY ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT A ATTACHED AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; NO MONETARY CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE SECTION 6503.5; LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF NO LESS THAN \$300,000.


