**CONTINUATION OF RENT**

**LESSEE:**

Pacific Lumber Company  
P. O. Box 37  
Scotia, CA 95565

**AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:**

0.26 acres, more or less, of sovereign lands in the Eel River near Dyerville,  
Humboldt County.

**AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of a railroad flat car used for a seasonal bridge  
crossing in the Eel River, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

**LEASE TERM:**

30 years, beginning July 28, 1981.

**CONSIDERATION:**

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease  
term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under  
this lease, and recommends that the rent be continued at \$100 per year, effective  
July 28, 2003.

**OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

The Commission has authorized a General Lease - Right of Way Use to Pacific  
Lumber Company for a term of 30 years. The lease will expire on July 27, 2011.  
The seasonal crossing facilitates the Lessee's lumber operations in the area.




