CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF THE FULL QUITCLAIM DEED OF NEGOTIATED SUBSURFACE (NO SURFACE USE)
OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 8557.1 (A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS LYING WITHIN THE BED OF SUISUN BAY),
CONTRA COSTA AND SOLANO COUNTIES.

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Negotiated Subsurface (No Surface Use) Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8557.1 contains approximately 335 acres of tide and submerged lands within the bed of Suisun Bay, Contra Costa and Solano Counties, California.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8557.1 (Lease) was issued to Rio Delta Resources, Inc. and Russell H. Green, Jr. (collectively lessee) on August 17, 2004. Each acquired a 50 percent (50%) undivided interest in the Lease. The negotiated subsurface lease contains 335 acres of tide and submerged lands within the bed of Suisun Bay in Contra Costa and Solano Counties, California (leased lands). Under the terms of the Lease, the lessee is required to pay an annual rental of \$20 per acre (\$6,700 for 335 acres) and commence drilling operations on the leased lands within five years.

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To date, no drilling or associated well operations have been conducted on the lease, no surface occupancy or disturbance of any kind has occurred and no wells have been drilled into or through the lease.

Public Resources Code section 6804.1 and Lease Paragraph 29 permit the lessee to make, at any time, a written quitclaim of all rights under the lease or of any portion of the leased lands comprising a ten-acre parcel or multiple thereof in a compact form. The quitclaim is effective when it is filed with the State subject to the continued obligation of the lessee and its surety to pay all accrued rentals and royalties and to abandon all wells drilled on the leased lands.

On July 16, 2008, the Commission's staff received the document "(Full) Quitclaim Deed for State Oil and Gas Lease." This document was dated June 30, 2008, and quitclaims back to the State all of the lessee's right, title and interest in the leased lands described in Exhibit A, attached hereto, of Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8557.1.

A review of the Commission's files reveals that no default exists on the Lease, that the lessee has complied with all applicable laws and Lease provisions, and has paid all rentals (no royalty is due as the leased lands were not developed).

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. 


