REVISION OF RENT

LESSEE:

Edward R. Frazer

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 4796 North Lake Boulevard, near Carnelian Bay, Placer County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, portion of a cabin, boat lift, and two mooring buoys as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

LEASE TERM:

Ten years, beginning June 30, 2005.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that the rent be revised from \$50 per year to \$109 per year, effective June 30, 2010.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On June 26, 2006, the Commission authorized a General Lease – Recreational Use with Edward R. Frazer, for the continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, portion of a cabin, boat lift, and two mooring buoys. The pier, boat lift, and two mooring buoys qualify for rent-free status pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6503.5, because they are used for the mooring and docking of boats. However, the portion of the cabin that is located on the lease premises is not used for the mooring and docking of boats and is subject to rent.
2. The two mooring buoys, previously authorized by the Commission were permitted by the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency on September 25, 2009.
