CONSIDER APPROVAL OF A PARTIAL ASSIGNMENT OF STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 8395.1 FROM STREAM ENERGY, INC. TO SUMMIT EXPLORATION (CALIFORNIA), LLC, AND APPROVE SUMMIT EXPLORATION (CALIFORNIA), LLC AS OPERATOR OF THE LEASE, SNODGRASS SLOUGH, SACRAMENTO COUNTY

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8395.1 currently contains approximately 44.32 acres of tide and submerged land situated in the bed of Snodgrass Slough in Sacramento County, California.

BACKGROUND:

State Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8395.1 was originally issued to Sunset Exploration, Inc. (Sunset) on June 18, 2002. The original lease contained approximately 30.3 acres of tide and submerged land in the bed of Snodgrass Slough in Sacramento County. On March 25, 2008, the California State Lands Commission (Commission) approved the assignment of 100 percent (100%) interest in the Lease to Stream Energy, Inc. (Stream) and amended the lease to include an additional of 14.02 acres of the State tide and submerged land underlying Snodgrass Slough for a total of 44.32 lease acres.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Stream has submitted assignment forms requesting Commission approval to assign an undivided 75 percent of its interest in the lease to Summit Exploration (California), LLC (Summit). Summit has also applied to be named the new operator for the lease. Staff has reviewed all requisite financial documentation submitted by Summit and has determined that Summit is capable of meeting the financial obligations set forth in the lease. Summit has provided an Irrevocable Letter of Credit (ILOC) as security and will be responsible for making all rental and royalty payments due under the lease.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION

1. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines [Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15060, subd. 
