CONTINUATION OF RENT

LESSEES:

Bradford D. Pappalardo and Katherine L. Pappalardo

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

0.350 acre, more or less, of sovereign land in Steamboat Slough, adjacent to 12530 Grand Island Road, near Walnut Grove, Sacramento County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing uncovered accommodation dock, gangway, dolphins, pilings, and debris diverter for a private boat club known as Steamboat Resort Club.

LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning February 3, 2006.

CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that rent be continued at \$1,400 per year, effective February 3, 2013.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. On February 9, 2006, the Commission authorized a General Lease Commercial Use to Bradford D. Pappalardo and Katherine L. Pappalardo. The lease will expire February 2, 2026. Staff conducted the rent review called for in the lease and as a result, staff is recommending that the rent be continued.
- 2. The staff recommends that the Commission find that the subject continuation of rent does not have a potential for resulting in either a direct or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and is, therefore, not a project in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
