GENERAL LEASE – RECREATIONAL USE

APPLICANT:

Brembil, LLC, a California Limited Liability Company

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in Lake Tahoe, adjacent to 171 Paradise Flat Lane, near Rubicon Bay, El Dorado County.

AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, boat lift, and four mooring buoys.

LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning June 1, 2012.

CONSIDERATION:

\$2,755 per year, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease.

SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Insurance:

Liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$1,000,000.

Other:

The proposed lease contains a provision requiring the Applicant to obtain authorization from the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for the mooring buoys within two years after the adoption of a Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) for the Lake Tahoe Shorezone Ordinance Amendments and approval of the amended ordinances. This is a continuation of the process the Commission used from approximately 1995 to October 2008 when TRPA adopted an FEIS and Ordinance Amendments supported by the FEIS. In September 2010, the U.S. District Court invalidated the FEIS and nullified the Amendments. When additional information is available, Commission staff will advise the Commission on any suggested modifications to the process used by the

Commission pending resolution of the TRPA FEIS and amended ordinance issues.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. Applicant owns the upland parcels adjoining the lease premises.
- 2. On June 18, 2002, the Commission authorized a 10-year General Lease Recreational Use to Brembil, LLC, a California Limited Liability Company for construction of a new pier, installation of a boatlift, and four existing mooring buoys. The Applicant owns two neighboring parcels, Assessor's Parcel Numbers 017-021-28 and 017-021-30, each with two adjacent mooring buoys. The lease expired May 31, 2012. Applicant is now applying for a new General Lease – Recreational Use for the existing facilities.
- 3. The staff recommends that the Commission find that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1, Existing Facilities; California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 2905, subdivision (a)(2).

Authority: Public Resources Code section 21084 and California Code of Regulations, Title 14, section 15300 and California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 2905.

4. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370 et seq., but such activity will not affect those significant lands. Based upon the staff's consultation with the persons nominating such lands and through the CEQA review process, it is the staff's opinion that the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.

SIGNIFICANT LANDS INVENTORY FINDING:

Find that this activity is consistent with the use classification designated by the Commission for the land pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6370 et seq.

AUTHORIZATION:

Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use to Brembil, LLC, a California Limited Liability Company beginning June 1, 2012, for a term of 10 years, for the continued use and maintenance of an existing pier, boat lift, and four mooring buoys as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B (for reference purposes only) attached and by this reference made a part hereof; annual rent in the amount of \$2,755 per year, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rent periodically during the lease term, as provided in the lease; and liability insurance in the amount of no less than \$1,000,000.

EXHIBIT A

LAND DESCRIPTION

Five (5) parcels of submerged land situate in the bed of Lake Tahoe, lying adjacent to Lot 4 of fractional Section 4, Township 13 North, Range 17 East, MDM., as shown on Official Government Township Plat approved May 19, 1875, County of El Dorado, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1 - PIER

All those lands underlying an existing pier, catwalk and boatlift lying adjacent to those Parcels as described in Exhibit "A" of that Grant Deed recorded June 28, 2000 in Document Number 2000-0031961 in Official Records of said County.

TOGETHER WITH a ten foot impact area.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of elevation 6223 feet LTD on the shoreline of said Lake Tahoe.

PARCEL 2, 3, 4 & 5 – BUOYS

Four (4) circular parcels of land, each being 50 feet in diameter, underlying four (4) existing buoys lying adjacent to said Parcels.

Accompanying plat is hereby made part of this description.
