# **REVISION OF RENT**

#### LESSEE:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company

#### LAND TYPE AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in the Mokelumne and the Cosumnes Rivers, near the city of Elk Grove, Sacramento and San Joaquin Counties.

#### AUTHORIZED USE:

The construction, use, operation, and maintenance of a 24-inch-diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline and maintenance of four existing slurried deactivated eight-inch-diameter pipelines.

#### LEASE TERM:

20 years, beginning March 25, 2008.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff has conducted a review of the rent under this lease and recommends that rent be revised from \$230 per year to \$295 per year, effective March 25, 2014.

#### **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

- On March 25, 2008, the Commission authorized the issuance of Lease No. PRC 8777.1, a General Lease - Right-of-Way Use, to Pacific Gas and Electric Company for the construction, use, operation and maintenance of a 24-inch-diameter welded steel natural gas pipeline and maintenance of four existing slurried deactivated eight-inch-diameter pipelines. The lease will expire on March 24, 2028.
- 2. Staff conducted a rent review called for in the lease and recommends rent be increased.

3. Staff recommends that the Commission find that the subject revision of rent does not have a potential for resulting in either a direct or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and is, therefore, not a project in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
