#### **GENERAL LEASE – RECREATIONAL USE**

#### APPLICANTS:

Kim Desenberg and Anna Desenberg, Trustees of the Desenberg Trust dated June 22, 2002

#### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land located in Tomales Bay, adjacent to 12884 Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, near Inverness, Marin County.

#### AUTHORIZED USE:

Continued use and maintenance of an existing pier with platform, ramp, floating boat dock, and four pilings.

#### LEASE TERM:

10 years, beginning June 22, 2012.

#### **CONSIDERATION:**

\$186 per year, with an annual Consumer Price Index adjustment.

#### SPECIFIC LEASE PROVISIONS:

Liability insurance in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.

#### **OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:**

- 1. Applicants own the upland adjoining the lease premises.
- On December 16, 2002, the Commission authorized a 10-year Recreational Pier Lease with Kim Desenberg and Anna Desenberg, Trustees of the Desenberg Trust dated June 22, 2002. The lease expired on June 21, 2012. The Applicants are now applying for a General Lease – Recreational Use.
- 3. The staff recommends that the Commission find that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as a categorically exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 1,

Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational Use to Kim Desenberg and Anna Desenberg, Trustees of the Desenberg Trust dated June 22, 2002, beginning June 22, 2012, for a term of 10 years, for the continued use and maintenance of an existing pier with platform, ramp, floating boat dock, and four pilings, as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B (for reference purposes only) attached and by this reference made a part hereof; annual rent in the amount of \$186, with an annual Consumer Price Index adjustment; and liability insurance in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence.
