### **REVISION OF RENT**

### LESSEE:

Time Warner Telecom of California, L.P.

### AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Sovereign land in the San Joaquin River, Laird Slough, Tuolumne River, and Merced River, near Grayson, Herndon, Atwater, and the city of Modesto, Stanislaus, Madera, Merced, and Fresno Counties.

### **AUTHORIZED USE:**

Continued use and maintenance of an existing 8-inch diameter steel black iron pipe casing containing six 2-inch diameter high density polyethylene conduit ducts with fiber-optic cable within four of the six ducts.

#### LEASE TERM:

25 years, beginning February 1, 1998.

### CONSIDERATION:

This lease provides that Lessor may modify the rent periodically during the lease term. Pursuant to this provision, staff conducted a review of the rent under this lease, and recommends that rent be revised from \$767 per year to \$2,700 per year, effective February 1, 2015.

### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On February 27, 1998, the Commission authorized a General Lease – Right-of-Way Use to GST Telecom California, Inc. (GST), for the directional boring, placement and maintenance of an 8-inch diameter steel black iron pipe casing containing six 2-inch diameter high density polyethylene conduits, one of which is used for a fiber optic cable.

- 2. On September 19, 2000, the Commission approved an Amendment of and Consent to Co-location of this lease, which authorized 360networks (USA), Inc. to utilize a fiber optic cable within the right-of-way. The Commission also authorized the installation of one additional fiber optic cable into the existing conduit, for a total of two (2) fiber optic cables with one (1) fiber optic cable to be used by GST and one (1) fiber optic cable by 360networks.
- 3. On September 19, 2000, the Commission also approved an Amendment and Consent to Co-location of this lease which authorized Williams Communication, Inc. to utilize a fiber optic cable within the right-of-way; and authorized the installation of two (2) additional fiber optic cables into the existing conduit.
- 4. On January 10, 2001, GST filed bankruptcy and Time Warner Telecom of California, L.P. purchased all assets and assumed the lease.
- 5. Six (6) conduit ducts are authorized under the subject lease, which contain a total number of four (4) fiber optic cables as follows: two (2) fiber optic cables are used by Williams, one (1) fiber optic cable is used by Time Warner, and one (1) fiber optic cable is used by 360 networks.
- 6. The staff recommends that the Commission find that the subject revision of rent does not have a potential for resulting in either a direct or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment, and is, therefore, not a project in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).




Approve the revision of rent for Lease No. PRC 8014.1 from \$767 per year to \$2,700 per year, effective February 1, 2015.
