CONSIDER ACCEPTANCE OF THE "LEASE QUITCLAIM DEED FOR STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE," NEGOTIATED SUBSURFACE (NO SURFACE USE) OIL AND GAS LEASE NO. PRC 8505.1, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

APPLICANT/LESSEE:

AREA, LAND TYPE, AND LOCATION:

Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8505.1 contains approximately 21 acres of tide and submerged lands in the bed of San Joaquin River, San Joaquin County, California (Exhibit A, Legal Description, attached hereto).

BACKGROUND:

Negotiated subsurface (no surface use) Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8505.1 (Lease) was issued to OXY Resources California LLC (OXY) on February 2, 2004, and contains approximately 21 acres of tide, submerged and proprietary lands in the bed of San Joaquin River in San Joaquin County, California (Exhibit B, location of leased lands, attached hereto).

On February 22, 2006, OXY changed its name in regard to this Lease to a wholly owned subsidiary, Vintage Production California LLC. On December 5, 2014, OXY spun off its California assets into an independent and separately traded company. The new company is California Resources Corporation (CRC), which has operations solely in California. Vintage Production California LLC was renamed California Resources Production Corporation (CRPC) and is a wholly owned subsidiary of CRC.

Surface locations for oil and gas operations (drill sites) were not available because the State land is a waterway. However, it was unknown if oil and gas resources were underneath lands within the Commission's jurisdiction. The Lease did authorize directional drilling from an adjacent upland drill site.

Under the terms of the Lease, the Lessee was required to pay royalty of 20 percent on all gas and oil production determined to be from the leased lands, in addition to an annual rental of \$50 per acre (\$1,050 for 21 acres). The Lessee provided a performance bond in the sum of \$10,000.

In November 2003, the San Joaquin County Community Development Department approved the application by OXY to drill the Roza 1-33 well on an upland site. Subsequently, the Division of Oil, Gas, and Geothermal Resources issued a permit for this well and the well was drilled in December 2003. The well proved uneconomic and CRPC has no plans for future development of this lease. No wells were drilled on or into the leased lands.

On February 6, 2015, the Commission received the document "Lease Quitclaim Deed for State Oil and Gas Lease." The document (Exhibit C, attached hereto) was dated February 2, 2015, and quitclaims back to the State all of the Lessee's right, title and interest in the Lease.

Public Resources Code section 6804.1 and paragraph 29 of the Lease, permit the lessee to, at any time, quitclaim all rights under the Lease. The quitclaim is effective when it is filed with the State subject to the continued obligation of the Lessee, and its surety, to pay all accrued rentals and royalties and to abandon all wells drilled on or through the leased lands.

A review of the Commission's files reveals that no default exists on the Lease. that the Lessee has complied with all applicable laws and Lease provisions and has paid all rentals. No royalty is due as the leased lands were not developed.

- Accept from California Resources Production Corporation (Lessee) the "Lease Quitclaim Deed for State Oil and Gas Lease," Lease No. PRC 8505.1, dated February 2, 2015, wherein the Lessee quitclaims back to the State all right, title and interest in the leased lands described in Exhibit B, attached hereto.
- 2. Release California Resources Production Corporation from all obligations under Oil and Gas Lease No. PRC 8505.1 accruing after February 2, 2015, the filing date of the quitclaim deed.
- 3. Authorize the Executive Officer or her designee to execute any documents necessary to implement the Commission's action.

BEGINNING at the northwest corner of that certain Lease Parcel described in Document Number 2003-030019 recorded February 10, 2003 in official records of said county having approximate California Coordinate System 1983, Zone 3 North y-coordinate = 2148110 feet and East x-coordinate = 6320910 feet; thence the following four (4) courses:

1.	N90°00'00"E	4090.00 feet;
2.	N00°00'00"E	3480.00 feet;
3.	N90°00'00"W	4090.00 feet;
4.	S00°00'00"E	3480.00 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of said San Joaquin River.

This description is based on the California Coordinate System of 1983, Zone 3.


